House Bill 58 Passes the House. Now on to the Senate.

The House of Representatives passed a law to strengthen DUI laws in Kentucky on Thursday that will require that an ignition interlock device be installed on the automobile of anyone convicted of a DUI offense. The House voted overwhelmingly (95-0) to support House Bill 58. The legislation now moves to the Kentucky Senate for its consideration. Representative Dennis Keene of Wilder sponsored the bill along with 53 co-sponsors.

State Representative Keene currently serves as Chair of Licensing and Occupations Committee; Vice Chair of Economic Development Committee; Member of Banking and Insurance Committee and Member of Local Government Committee.

The Whirlpool Corp. is closing a refrigerator manufacturing plant in Evansville, Ind., putting more than 1,100 people out of work. Even worse, Whirlpool will continue to produce these refrigerators, but not in Evansville and not anywhere else in America. They are planning to manufacture them in Mexico, where weaker labor and environmental laws make them "cheaper" for Whirlpool to produce.

This is outrageous and unacceptable, especially in light of Whirlpool's profitability and the \$19 million dollars in economic recovery money Whirlpool recently received from the

federal government as a part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act. Those are OUR economic recovery funds, not Mexico's.

To protest Whirlpool's decisions and demand good jobs in America, I'm heading to Evansville next Friday to rally and march with local workers and labor leaders—and I'd like you to join me. No, I'm not asking you to join me in person, but I would like you to sign a petition in solidarity with the Evansville workers for me to deliver to Whirlpool's management.
